Code of Conduct Policy

To ensure that the W.B. Sullivan is enjoyed by all and in keeping with the traditions of the game, the competition committee requires competitors in the event to follow a Code of Conduct on and off the course while present at the host facility.

1. Competitors will be in violation of this Code of Conduct if they engage in abusive language, club throwing, disrespect of volunteers or officials, abuse of the golf course, not adhering to the dress code during any practice or tournament round, leaving the course during a competitive round without permission of an official, vandalism, abusive behavior to employees of host facility, and otherwise failing to conduct themselves in keeping with the game's traditions, which include respect for fellow competitors.
2. The Championship Committee may assess any or all of the following penalties based on the severity of the Code of Conduct violation: Issue a written letter of warning to the player, Rejection of entry or entries of the player including during the competition, Removal of a player from the course and disqualification, Suspend the player's eligibility for future events for a specified period or for an indefinite period, Assess a stroke or multi-stroke penalty based on the severity of the violation.

Pace of Play Policy

The Championship Committee has established the following “Group Based” Guidelines regarding Pace of Play. Rule 6-7 states “The players must play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play guidelines that the Committee may establish.”

- Players will be provided the Pace of Play Policy on their first tee, and are expected to adhere to the Policy indicated.
- The W.B. Sullivan Pace of Play Policy is 4 Hours, 28 Minutes, and utilizes a TWO Checkpoint system
 - Checkpoints will be #9 and #18 green
 - Each Group is responsible for monitoring their own pace.
 - To avoid penalty, groups must complete each checkpoint under the allotted time (2 hours 14 minutes per side), or within 14 minutes of the group ahead.
- First groups off either tee will be in breach of the Pace of Play Policy if they fail to reach the checkpoint in the allotted time
- Subsequent groups will be in breach of the Pace of Play Policy if they fail to reach a checkpoint in the allotted time, or if they fail to reach a checkpoint within 14 minutes of the group ahead, who is on time.

As a rule of thumb, you are “out of position” if

- Your group has reached the teeing ground of a par 3 and the group in front has cleared the next teeing ground
- Your group has reached the teeing ground of a par 4 and the hole is clear
- Your group has reached the teeing ground of a par 5 and the group ahead is on the green

THERE WILL BE NO TIMING PROCEDURES. GROUPS MAY BE WARNED IF THEY ARE OUT OF POSITION. HOWEVER, FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE TIME AND CHECKPOINT POSITIONS WILL RESULT IN A TWO SHOT PENALTY FOR EACH OCCURRENCE. SHOULD THE COMMITTEE DECIDE THAT A DIFFERENT RATE OF PLAY IS REQUIRED DUE TO ABNORMAL CONDITIONS, THE COMMITTEE WILL COMMUNICATE WITH THE PARTICIPANTS.
