PLAYING LESSONS

Playing lessons emphasize course management and strategy—both in general terms as well as specific to the skill set of the individual.

The intent is for the professional to help you identify your strengths and weaknesses and a personal management strategy that will help you get the most out of your current skill set.

Some holes will be played out, others will not. Playing lessons give the professional an opportunity to design and prioritize a lesson program for your personal approach to lower scores.

Playing lessons are 30-90 minutes in length and are best scheduled for afternoons when course availability is expected.

Wednesday Play Days

More important than technical skill is the ability for children to “learn how to play.” Where do I walk? Where do I stand?

When is it my turn? How do I rake a bunker?

It is invaluable experience for children to be “on the course.”

PARENTS ARE WELCOME TO WALK ALONG!

If you do...I ask that you don't carry their bags, rake their bunkers, or instruct. You are there for support. Tell them how well they are doing. Let them know where to stand, or when it's their turn. If score is being kept, let them keep their own!

This is a process. Not everything will be perfect the first Wednesday. The goal is to get them prepared for the next week, and then the next week, and the next, and so on.

CREATING A LOVE AFFAIR

In addition to the clinics and Play Days, we'd like to create an environment of opportunities outside of their own game. With that in mind, here are some additional activities we will offer.

Saturday Morning Caddie Training

Each Saturday beginning June 15, kids can sign up to “caddie.” This is not carrying bags for money. This is a volunteer opportunity to walk alongside adult players and learn “how to play.” Parents are welcome to accompany their child. The “caddie experience” begins on the first tee and ends on the sixth green. This is an opportunity for children to watch “the real pros” - our members!

W.B. Sullivan Volunteers

Children will have the opportunity to be volunteer “spotters” during the Sullivan. The goal is to provide a safe environment to assist excellent amateurs on the course. We will use Hole #11 and Hole #15 for sure. Shifts will be assigned depending on the number who register.
