



Lebanon Country Club Guidelines

Golf Dress Code Policy

- All attire must be tailored and in good taste.
- Billed hats and visors must be worn in the traditional manner, not backwards or sideways.
- Lebanon Country Club is a soft spikes facility. Metal spikes are prohibited.
- Dress shoes or other hard-soled shoes shall not be worn on the golf course, practice green or practice facility. Golf shoes and tennis shoes are permitted on those areas.
- Denim (jeans, shorts or shirts) of any color is prohibited.
- Children and Guests must be appropriately dressed in accordance with the Club's Dress Code.

Ladies' Attire

- Banded golf shirts may be worn untucked.
- Tank tops, tube tops and halter tops are prohibited.
- Golf skirts, culottes and shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh length.
- Leggings, sweat pants, cut-offs, short shorts, tennis shorts, jogging attire, bathing suits, cargo shorts and pants (including "grunge/skateboard-style") or denim shorts and pants of any color are prohibited.

Men's Attire

- Golf shirts must have a collar (standard style, turtleneck or mock style) and must be tucked in at all times.
- Sweat pants, cut-offs, tennis shorts, jogging attire, bathing suits, paratrooper, cargo shorts and pants (including "grunge/skateboard-style") or denim shorts and pants of any color are prohibited.

Special events sponsored by the Club may allow less formal attire. Notice of these events will be communicated to the Members.

When rule infractions occur, it is the Club policy for management to address the infraction. If infractions continue to occur, it is Club policy to notify the member via a letter from the Board of Governors.

Dining Dress Code

- Generally speaking, golf attire is appropriate in all areas of the Clubhouse with the exception of spiked shoes
- Men shall remove billed hats and visors when inside the Club dining areas.
- Men's shirts must have a collar (standard style, turtleneck or mock style) and must be tucked in at all times.
- Smart Casual attire including dress denim is permitted in the Pine Room and Casual section of the Fairway Dining Room.
- Pool-type attire is prohibited in the clubhouse, patio and clubhouse deck
- Members are responsible for the attire of their children and guests on club property at all times.

Smoking Policy

Lebanon Country Club is a smoke-free facility. Smoking is permitted outside but limited to designated areas. These designated areas are depicted by the waste receptacles. In general, smoking is not permitted within 20 feet of the main ballroom entrance nor the lower level breezeway entrance. We appreciate your attention to the proper disposal of smoking residue.

Cell Phones

When dining at the Club, cell phones must be placed on silent, vibrate, or turned off. If it is necessary to take the call, you should excuse yourself from the dining rooms and take the call in another area that does not interrupt those who are dining. On the golf course, cell phones should only be used to report emergencies, equipment problems, and course damage.

Special events sponsored by the Club may allow less formal attire. Notice of these events will be communicated to the Members.
